### Advanced TacAudioScan

In addition to the choices of sounds produced by the "box" (beep, click, double click, and arcade), you have the option to connect an external music source (MP3 player or CD player) to provide the audio which is split bilaterally. The audio is synchronized with the bilateral speed of the vibration of the pulsers. With the MegaPulser upgrade, it is \$239 + shipping (\$15.50)

TacAudioScan is the simplest version. It provides the beep/tone (like a hospital monitor sound) and vibrating pulsers. With the MegaPulser upgrade, it is \$149 + shipping (\$15.50)

Whichever one you choose, ask for the MegaPulser Upgrade when you order. (additional \$30). The MegaPulsers have small lights in the top that are activated w the vibration. They plug into a standard 3.5mm male mini jack Audio Cable Stereo Y adapter to 2 RCA male adapters

I get the following from eBay (much cheaper than Neurotek)

Replacement stereo cable 3.5 to RCA (nervous clients will wrap them around their fingers and break the wires) (

Extender cable (3.5 male to female) (12ft, \$2.89 & 25ft \$5.62) you need two: one for headphones & one for pulsers

I get cheap stereo headphones from Big Lots (\$5-6)
